In Memoriam, Cassandra Lease:

Cassandra Lease died on February 2, 2021.

Cass epitomized the spirit of the larger Arisia community bringing accountability to the corporation in November of 2018. She had never been a corporate member before, but stepped forward as a new member, as a spokesperson for the community within the corporation, and then as a board member, and others followed her. She helped facilitate a smooth transfer of power and put tremendous effort into the work Arisia faced over the following year. She was strong in her commitment to safety and diversity and skilled in her—and our—expression of that commitment.

As we grieve and move forward, may we honor her memory by working together, being brave enough to speak our minds and our truth, and continuing our efforts to make Arisia a safer, more diverse place.

Officer and Committee Reports

Eboard report:

As reported last month, we are in the process of applying for a \$3,000 Universal Participation grant from the Massachusetts Cultural Council. We have passed the first gate and the deadline for completing the second gate application is this Friday (February 26). There is enough grant money to fund most of the organizations that have gotten this far, so we are optimistic. There is also a \$10,000 "best of" grant which is much more of a long shot. We are also looking at other grants.

We have a proposal to upgrade the memory in the sixteen registration computers so they can run Windows 10 instead of Windows 7 without being vastly slower than before. We have not taken a formal vote on this but expect to approve an expense of between \$20 and \$25 each, or \$320 to \$400 total.

For some time we have been intending to open new bank accounts to resolve an ownership issue with the existing accounts. We have received a recommendation from the Anti-Racism Committee (ARC) to open the new accounts at OneUnited Bank, which is the only Black-owned bank in Massachusetts. We are awaiting additional information about the account types there to ensure they meet our needs before acting on this proposal.

President's report:

At etana's request, I am appointing Dan Franklin to the Anti-Racism Committee.

There is an Incident Report (IR) that the eBoard has voted on, but which we were unable to send to the Corporate list within the approved-upon time. This will be sent out prior to the March 2021 corporate meeting ino order to be reported out.

Motion: Set the date of the May 2021 Corporate meeting to Sunday, May 16th at 2pm - Passes

Treasurer's report:

Dues to join Arisia today are \$14. If paid prior to the end of the meeting, today will count as your first meeting towards membership, so you will gain voting/proxy rights at the next meeting. There were no out-of-budget spending items in January, 2021 to report.

Arisia 2021:

The treasury books are not yet closed on the convention, however it is not expected to result in a surplus or revenue. We had fewer registrations overall compared to in-person convention years, but many of the virtual ticket holders paid the higher ticket price. We have not yet decided which organization to donate the \$1,000 fund to once the books close on Arisia 2021.

Arisia 2022:

Functioning as a team, the Arisia 2022 conchair includes Gail Terman and Jodie Lawhorne alongside Vivian Abraham. Divisions are being redrawn as Teams, and many have hit the ground running! We are trying to get an early start to reduce the amount of stress later. Positions will be posted as teams decide their layout. We are planning a meeting some time in March called, "It's not October, let's talk about Zambia." If you are interested in getting involved with that, please email conchair.

The Town Hall occurred in February and while attendance was low, there were many useful things brought up. It did feel very community-oriented. There were requests to hold additional Town Halls and listening sessions. These would be separate from ConComms or Corporate meetings. Email conchair to give feedback if you were unable to attend.
