Officer and Committee Reports

Eboard report:

A'22 Code of Conduct Statement Regarding Covid-19 from the Eboard: the Eboard feels that the Arisia CoC covers any fictitious statement made on any convention document, including documents regarding C-19 vaccinations. The Eboard doesn't feel that the CoC needs to be amended regarding this. The A'22 Conchair is willing to accept this.

Bylaws change location for service animals & assistive devices: "Arisia expects its members to respect each other and behave in a responsible manner. Members should respect common sense rules for public behavior, personal interaction, common courtesy, and respect for private property. Assistive devices must be considered an extension of their users' bodily autonomy with regard to touching, photographing, and other conduct. Service dogs, as defined by the ADA, are also an extension of their handlers and must not be touched, photographed, deliberately distracted, or otherwise impeded without permission of their handler."

Discussed concerns about captioning, Arisia's recording policy. Note that the chat log of corporate meetings held on Zoom becomes a part of the minutes.

Anti-racism report:

This committee is focused on correcting implicit bias at the corporate level, focusing specifically on policies and procedures that are non-inclusive. To that end, Etana has found a cultural competency assessment tool for those of us in the committee to evaluate, before passing it on to the members of the corporation as a whole. Our other focus at the moment is finding a more inclusive guide for holding meetings than Robert's Rules. Old Business:

A'21 Donation CPA Conversation Results: We can donate to like organizations. So an educational group focused on PoC would work. Or, we could change our charter to be able to donate to groups outside the current group. Phi plans to donate the amount personally to the groups that we originally named.

Medford Public Library Donation. We will need to move funds to cover this grant. We have about \$18,000 in unallocated funds, and expect another \$18,000 from Arisia 21. We just approved an Arisia 22 budget of \$34,000. We have a \$4,500 contingency fund. We think a \$2,500 grant is something we can currently afford. As a non-profit it is key that we keep giving out grants. We are also seeking grants to help cover costs. It would be great if we had a short list of These are the kinds of things we give money to. We prefer to give money that are accessible, etc. that fit with our values.
