EBoard Report:

The EBoard voted to spend \$100 for filters for the Corsi-Rosenthal boxes Arisia is loaning to SMOFcon. In addition, the EBoard voted to spend \$300 for ADA-compliant cord covers for the Tech Division that will last for many years. These covers will enable people with mobility device to traverse cords that have been run across paths of travel at Arisia events.

Treasurer's Report:

The Corporation has signed a lease with our storage space. The new lease includes a slight increase in rent, which will get a bit larger in future years of the lease. The Corporation's Snow Fund will therefore increase, and this will be reflected in the next financial report.

Clerk's Report:

Rachel discussed the role of the Corporate Communications Committee. In the recent past, this committee has assisted the Clerk. As Clerk, Rachel mostly could use help with looking over draft minutes for errors and stylistic suggestions, and occasional note-taking at meetings. If committee members are interested in being called on to help with these things from time to time, that could be one purpose for the committee. Priscilla volunteered to help proofread minutes. Committee nominations can only be carried out by the Arisia President, who was not present, so this issue will be addressed at the December meeting.

A24 Con Comm Report:

Programming, Fast Track, Youth Services, Gaming, and Events are proceeding and are in Ilene's wheelhouse. Social media notices about the convention and related preparations have gone out regularly. Melissa is meeting with the hotel to discuss a new BEO system. The Con Chairs have signed contracts for sound equipment for Tech and radios for Safety, and are about to put in an order for masks for Safety. Guest of Honor travel arrangements have been made. The Con Chairs are requesting art for convention materials from the Artist Guest of Honor. Truck drivers have been identified for Logistics.

Committee Reports:

Anti-Racism Committee:

The committee's Chair indicated that the committee had disbanded in 2022, but other members of the committee responded that they had not known. Members agreed that no vote had been taken to disband the committee. Several members had quit the committee and meetings had suffered from scheduling and attendance issues. Upon reflection, the Chair stated that the committee had been inactive rather than disbanded, and no one else had been interested in joining. The Chair then resigned, but announced that the committee's reading list still exists on Goodreads. Also, the Chair had previously conducted a listening tour of Comics in Color on behalf of the committee, of which the Con Chairs had been unaware. The Con Chairs asked for notes from this tour. The Chair will send a committee report next week.

The Vice President, who was chairing the meeting, called for a ten-minute break.

Corporate Inventory Control:

Kylie Selkirk is interested in being on the Corporate Inventory Control (CIC) committee. This will be addressed at the December meeting, since only the President can nominate people to committees and the President is not in attendance.

It is not wheelchair-accessible, but the owner is working on getting grants to fix that. They, like us, are into community and education and anti-racism.
- SMOFcon will take place December 1-3, Providence, RI. Arisia provides scholarships. There are some discount rates on the website, including for folks accompanying active attendees but just want to hang out, first-timers, retired SMOFs, etc. Accessible by commuter rail and Amtrak from South Station.
