We filed our 990 in November and it has been accepted. We use a website run by a nonprofit to file the taxes; they charge larger organizations but we can use it for free. We gave them a small donation in appreciation of this service. MP (unanimously) to add \$5000 into the Grant Fund. Before this, the corporation had around \$20,000 in unallocated funds.
