#### **May 2012 Meeting Minutes**

**Time and place:** Meeting called to order by Rick Kovalcik at his house at 7:47 pm on May 22, 2012.

**Corrections to the minutes:** the minutes were for the April 24 meeting, not the March meeting.

**Eboard (Rick Kovalcik):** The eboard voted to lend art show equipment and staff den equipment to Chicon. We voted to lend pipe and drape to Concertino. The eboard met on May 1 and voted to recommend Lisa Hertel as con chair for Arisia 2014. *The membership voted to APPROVE Lisa's appointment 17-3*. Congratulations! Lisa is looking for suggestions for guests. Please email her privately.

**President (Rick Kovalcik):** I am still looking for someone to run the student art contest for 2013.

Vice President: No report.

**Treasurer (Ben Levy):** I paid the ASCAP and MPLC license for 2011 and ASCAP for 2009, which we apparently forgot to do. I purchased two copies of Robert's Rules of Order and a copy of Robert's Rules of Order In Brief. If we close the Arisia 2012 books by the end of the fiscal year and pay off the debts I am aware of, we will end the fiscal year with about the same amount of money as we started with. The audit is moving very very slowly.

**Clerk:** No report. **A12:** No report.

**A12 Treasury (Ben Levy):** We are hoping to close the books by the end of the fiscal year.

**A13 (Rachel Silber):** There is a concom meeting on May 29 at 7:30 at the NESFA clubhouse. We are working on the budget. We had a successful div head meeting to discuss space allocation and we have a draft budget which needs a whole lot of work. I am trying to quantify what we are doing with recruiting staff and found some interesting numbers about our staff. A10 had 11.6% earned comps. A11 had 10.5% and A12 had 9.5%. To come back up to the level we were at in 2010 we would need 40 new staff, which is an awful lot. Staff here is defined as anyone who worked 12 hours or more, since those are the numbers we have. The absolute numbers are going up, but not evenly. Crystal added 30 people, but the other years added only a few. I will be at the Relaxacon and I am happy to discuss budget or things to do at the con or recruiting thoughts with anyone at any time. Merv: we're growing the con. Are we growing the number of places we need staff? Some things will need to expand and some things will stay the same. Rachel: The only data I have are the earned comps. There is no detail, and also no total number of hours worked, and no breakdown for precon or at con. Although there are areas that don't need more staff as we grow, there are also places that get more complicated [faster than the con grows]. Merv: Can you get the raw timesheet info? Rachel: The google docs aren't very accurate or complete, and also don't account for hours worked by people who didn't earn comps. Merv: What does the raw timesheet say? Rachel: It's just the total number of hours worked. Skip: Sometimes it has had what department people worked in. Kris: There's no consistent online data. Several other people make this same point.

A14 (Lisa Hertel): I am looking for suggestions for guests.

**Art Show Capital Equipment Committee (Tom Murphy):** I need to buy a little more wood, and a few more ratchet down straps. I may go over budget a little.

CIC (Rick Kovalcik): there is still stuff from 3 personal members in storage who has to get it out of there. We're working on two of those. The eboard would like it if the remaining person dealt with this by July so that we can have some space to put things together for Chicon. Merv: The door has been fixed but the signage has not been updated.

Grant committee: no report.

**Hotel Search (Noel Rosenberg, by email):** We have a signed overflow contract with the Renaissance Boston Waterfront hotel for 2013. I hope to have a draft of the Westin contract addendum done this evening.

**Honors Committee (Nicholas Shectman):** I am looking for contact info for the family of Tom Fish. Lisa: We should send a sympathy card to Jan Dumas.

LRP: No report.

**Relaxacon** (**Kris Snyder**): Is in a little less than 2 weeks. We have over 40 people registered. It's going to be fun. If you registered more than 24 hours ago and haven't gotten an email from me with a food survey, please let me know so we can make sure that everyone is appropriately fed. If you have questions ask me after the meeting.

**SAC:** Vacant. Please see Rick if you're interested in working on the SAC.

**Budget (Ben Levy):** I've started working on the budget for next year.

#### Old business:

A bylaws amendment has been printed in MENTOR. MSPU (Shectman, Latzko) to call the question. Bylaws amendment passes 17-1.

M to cancel the August meeting. MSPU (Dumas, Carney) to amend by replacement to hold the August meeting on August 21 at a place and time to be determinged. Motion PASSES unanimously as amended.
